From Metro Boston, North and South Shore
Take MA Pike to Exit 10 (Auburn). 290 East (left after Toll Booth) to Exit 13 (Vernon St.) At the end of the ramp bear left.

From West
Take MA Pike East to Exit 10 (Auburn) to 290 bearing left after the toll booth. Stay on 290 to Exit 13 (Vernon St.) and at the end of the ramp, bear right.

From North
Take Rt. 190 to Rt. 290 and take Exit 13 (Vernon ST.) at the end of the ramp, bear right.

From Northeast
Take Rt. 495 to 290 West. Follow 290 to Exit 13 (Vernon St) at the end of the ramp, bear right.

From Above Directions
Enter "Kelley Square" intersection and rotary. Proceed past first right, take second right which will be Green St. (Hess Gas Station on the left.) Proceed down Green St. to set of lights under the Railroad Bridge. At this intersection you will see the back of the YWCA building. Take a left at lights (McGrath Blvd.) and your next right onto YWCA Way. Proceed down YWCA Way, keep bearing right until you come to the gate to the YWCA Parking Lot. Gate will automatically open (a \$1 token is needed to leave). If the Y Parking lot is full you may use the Municipal Lot behind the Library.
