## **Creative Activities for Probability and Statistics**

**C.A.P.S.** is a 12-week curriculum developed for after-school programs. It has proven to be a valuable tool in the school-day classroom as well. The curriculum reinforces math terminology through creative, movement-oriented activities. It also serves to subtly increase protective factors and reduce risk factors for teen problem gambling. The curriculum has been successfully implemented for youth in grades 3-10.

The 3-hour interactive training is designed to train in the utilization of this curriculum. Attendees will be participating in activities and learning first hand the manner in which the curriculum is meant to be implemented. The training will also increase participants' knowledge of teen gambling, and provide steps to increase awareness of the issue.

All attendees will receive a copy of the 12-week C.A.P.S. curriculum guide. The guide details each of the activities, contains instructions on all necessary supplies, has reproducible pages, and connects each of the activities to the Massachusetts State Standards being addressed.

This training is meant for Program Directors and staff, supervisors, and school teachers. Space is limited to the first 50 registrants. *Deadline is March 30th.*
