There are also clinics and medication assistance programs in some local communities that are able to help with immediate medication needs. We will work with you to evaluate your eligibility for these programs and services.

Many people have questions about their medications such as: “What is this medication for?” “When is the best time of day to take my medication?” “Does my medication have side effects?” “Do my over the counter or herbal medications interact with my prescription drugs?” Pharmacy Outreach Program pharmacists can answer your questions. A complete review of your medications is provided, including how and when to take them, possible ways to lower your medication costs and much more.
