

Tour of ARTZ (Artists for Alzheimer's®) Program at deCordova Sculpture Park and Museum

Friday, November 18 | 12:30 pm - 4:30 pm

Be one of the few attendees to visit the deCordova Sculpture Park and Museum and witness ARTZ, Artists for Alzheimer's®, in action. This groundbreaking program was first developed through a collaboration with the Museum of Modern Art in New York City, officially called "Meet Me at MoMA...and Make Memories." Through research and direct observation, ARTZ has already established that art experiences can significantly reduce certain psycho-behavioral symptoms so often associated with Alzheimer's disease.

Attendees will depart from the Hynes Convention Center at 12:30 pm for a 30 minute ride to the museum. Once there, attendees will have lunch, take an independent tour of the museum, and observe in the ARTZ museum program. Upon the conclusion of the visit, attendees will return to the Hynes Convention Center around 4:30 pm. Fee includes roundtrip motor coach transportation. Seating is limited to 20 people – there are a few spots left, so register today!
