SIGN UP TO HOST A FREE HOME ENERGY SAVINGS SEMINAR

The MMA is offering FREE Home Energy Saving Seminars for residents. We are seeking cities and towns to co-sponsor and host. You provide the location, publicity and logistical support; we provide the trainer and material.

Each seminar will cover key elements to reducing home energy costs. These key elements include:

- Identifying air sealing and insulation as the most cost-effective investment for reducing home energy costs.
- Providing information on cheap, do-it-yourself solutions to reducing cost of water, electricity, and heat (inc. programmable thermostats, CFLs, low-flow showerheads)
- Identifying available rebates and grants to reduce cost of home alterations and appliance purchases
- Referencing Energy Star ratings as indicator of product energy efficiency
- Providing information on MassSave home energy audits
